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- ▶ Scientific tasks
 - ▶ Assigning submissions to editors
 - ▶ Ensuring that the review process runs smoothly
- ▶ Non-scientific tasks **heavy...**
 - ▶ maintenance of the submission/review platform
 - ▶ helping editors struggling with the platform
 - ▶ maintenance of website
 - ▶ handling email problems (returned emails, etc)
 - ▶ maintenance of LaTeX style
 - ▶ creating journal issues
 - ▶ dblp
 - ▶ doi
 - ▶ ...
 - ▶ computers, disks, backups (Open Journal Hosting, Carleton)

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Risks

- ▶ Short-term: delays in publication
- ▶ Longer-term: sustainability?

Considering an option (?): apply to Dagstuhl

- ▶ Professional handling of non-scientific tasks
 - ▶ better quality, more efficient
- ▶ More time for managing editors \implies improved review process
- ▶ Long-term sustainability

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- ▶ ~ 150 € processing cost for each article
 - ▶ no profit
 - compare with ~ 2500 \$ for commercial publishers
 - or 1000 CHF (~ 930 €) for MDPI <https://www.mdpi.com/about>
 - ▶ cheap for most of us, waiver necessary for some of us
 - ▶ not compatible with the *Free Journal Network*
APCs must be "opt-in", never "opt-out"
