




Submissions

- **154** papers **2** withdrawn (2014: 175)
- 59 accepted
- 2015 (Eindhoven): 59/152 = 39 %
- 2014 (Kyoto): 60/175 = 34 %
- 2013 (Rio): 48/136 = 35 %
- 2012 (Chapel Hill): 44/124 = 35 %
- 2011 (Paris): 55/145 = 38 %
- 2010 (Snowbird): 47/145 = 32 %
- 2009 (Aarhus): 44/170 = 26 %
- 2008 (Washington): 42/127 = 33 %
- 2007 (Gyeongju): 45/139 = 32 %
- 2006 (Sedona): 54/138 = 39 %





Process



Almost everything done electronically through EasyChair

- Abstract submission: November 21
- PC bidding: November 25 November 30
- Paper submission: December 1
- Paper assignment: December 2
 - 3 PC members per paper; 28-29 per PC member
- Initial review phase: December 2 January 12
 - ~475 reviews (all papers at least 3)
 - ~240 external reviewers
- Discussion phase: January 13 February 11
 - Many accept/reject rounds
 - Much discussion (on some papers)
- Notification: February 11
- Reviews sent: February 16




Proceedings



- Proceedings done by LIPICS for the first time
- Process (relatively) smooth
 - We collected Latex and pdf through EasyChair
 - We collected copyright forms (and student presenters) by email
 - We added volume info and page numbers
 - We made front/back-matter
 - We sent latex and copyright forms to LIPICS
 - We uploaded metadata and pdf to LIPICS
 - LIPICS corrected latex and sent us change report and pdf
 - We (and not authors) checked pdf
 - LIPICS made web-portal
 - We checked web-portal
 - LIPICS registered DOIs and DBLP, archived with German National Library


