Workshop Submission Process

- We had five workshop proposals. Some were actively solicited. At least one more potential proposal was talked about but in the end not submitted.
- Two are repeating workshops.
- Two-tiered submission process: 12/15 intent to submit, 1/14 proposal due, 1/30 notification.
- Proposals were reviewed by all workshop committee members.
- All five proposals were accepted.
- Time slots essentially reflected minimum time requirements of the workshops.

Questions for the Community I

- How should time slots for the different CG week components (SoCG, workshops, YRF, multimedia) be allocated?
 - Lengthy discussions between the different PC/committee chairs and the SC.
