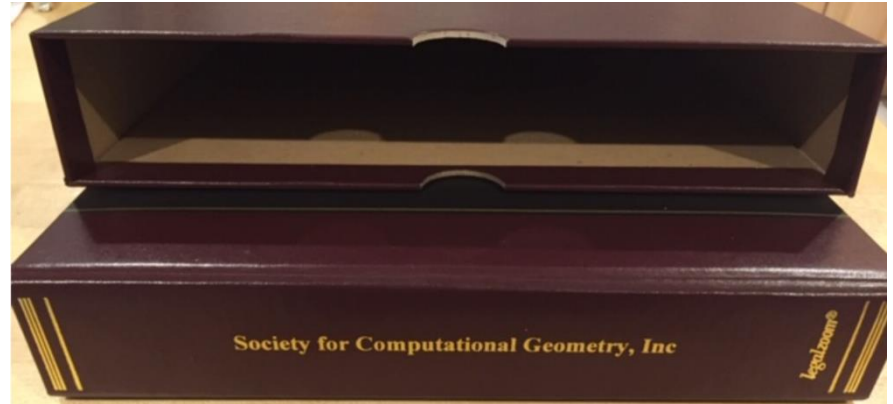

ByLaws

Section 2. Specific Objectives and Purposes

The specific objectives and purposes of this corporation shall be

- (a) to promote the free exchange of scientific research in computational geometry and computational topology;
- (b) to support or sponsor an annual meeting, known as “Computational Geometry Week” (CG Week), to include the International Symposium on Computational Geometry (SoCG);
- (c) to support or sponsor other workshops, educational forums, conferences and events in support of discrete and computational geometry, computational topology, and applications;
- (d) to support activities of the Steering Committee for CG Week;
- (e) to support other activities and publications that promote education and dissemination of scientific research in the areas of discrete and computational geometry, computational topology, and their applications.

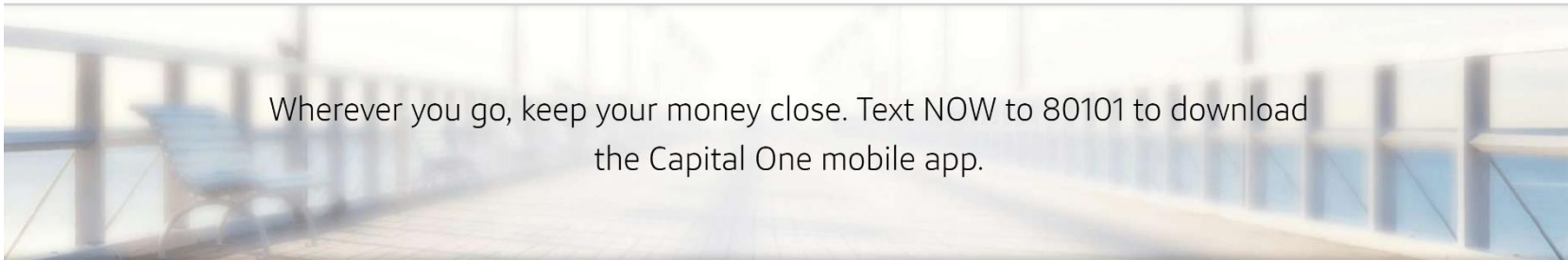

Initial and Ongoing Costs

- LegalZoom, fees to incorporate: \$397.10 (one-time)
- Registered Agent (Missouri): \$40.00/year
- Tax and accounting: Hope to do without fee...
- Bank account: Free (no monthly fees)

Revenue/Expenses Going Forward

- Donations within registration fees at CG Week annually: Estimated \$3000-5000 per year

Proposal: Commit to a particular amount (\$35) budgeted each year to be included in non-student registration fee as a donation to SoCG Society.

- Goal: Acquire (over about 10 years?) and maintain contingency fund of one year's conference budget in fund: About \$50,000
- Annual expenditures, potentially budgeted in conference budget, but paid via the Society:
 - Childcare (estimated \$0 – 5,000, annually)
 - Easychair pro?
 - Slack?
 - Insurance (as needed)
 - Awards?
 - Journal (JoCG) archiving costs?

Considerations

- Apply for 501(c)(3) status? Allows for (potentially) tax-deductible donations from individuals and companies (in USA)

(limited value with new 2017 tax laws in USA)

Considerable effort (and some expense) associated with this.... May not be worth it?

We are looking into it, consulting with tax expert.
