- $ightharpoonup \sim 150 \in$  processing cost for each article
  - No profit compare with ~ 2500 \$ for commercial publishers or 1000 CHF (~ 930 €) for MDPI https://www.mdpi.com/about
  - cheap for most of us, waiver necessary for some of us
  - ▶ not compatible with the Free Journal Network

    APCs must be "opt-in", never "opt-out"
