




#### Some numbers

- 2300 emails sent/received by the chairs (excluding EasyChair automatic messages), and counting. . .


# Submissions by category: submitted (outside) vs accepted (inside)



### Submissions by topic (selected by authors)




## Partition of the submissions into themes (hand-made)






